- Starting July 1st residents vote to decide which projects get funded.

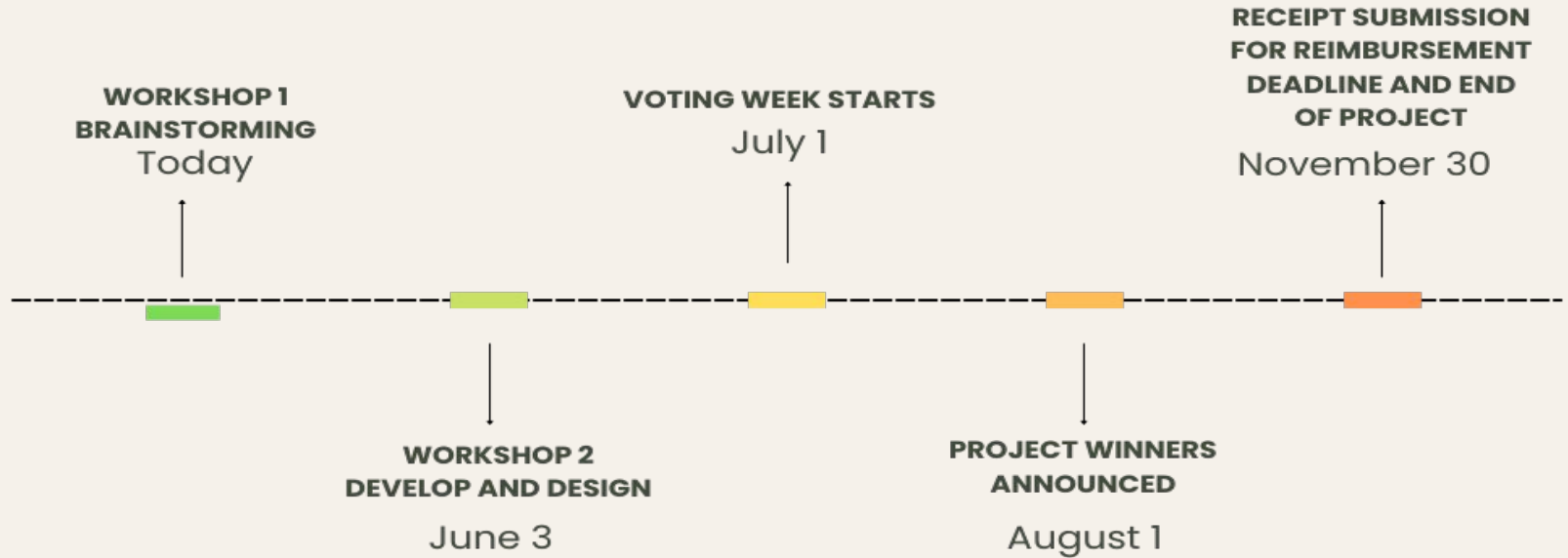


## Funding
